- The undergraduate courses at the college exhibited positive results in the final examinations of the year. B.COM. (HONS) and B.A (H) ENGLISH had notable performances with 88% and 94% pass rates, respectively.
- B.SC. (H) COMP. SCI and B.A. (H) POLITICAL SCIENCE also demonstrated strong outcomes, achieving pass rates of 88% and 94%.
- However, B.A. (H) SANSKRIT faced challenges, with only 62% of students passing.
- The overall pass rates for B.A (PROGRAMME), B.SC MATH SCIENCES, and B.SC. (H) STATISTICS were 87%, 97%, and 98%, respectively.
- Continuous monitoring and targeted interventions will further contribute to academic excellence.

Result Analysis Report for the Academic Year 2021-22

The college adhered to the University of Delhi's Academic for the 2021-22 academic year, conducting examinations for various programs following university guidelines. Each semester included a term-end examination, with teachers assessing students. Special measures were taken due to the pandemic. The university strictly followed evaluation normalization, appointing heads of examiners for all subjects, and recognizing examiners' commitment with certificates of appreciation. The overall pass rates are high across programs, with all programs having a commendable pass rate of over 90%.

For the 2020–21 academic year, the institution followed the University of Delhi's Academic Calendar 2020–21 and administered exams for a range of programs in accordance with university policies. There was a term-end exam at the end of each semester, and students were evaluated by their teachers (75% for the exam and 25% for internal assessment). The Examination Branch oversaw examination facility evaluation to preserve sanctity and confidentiality, whereas the university solely oversaw the exam schedule, hall passes, and paper setup. The university appointed heads of examiners for every subject and awarded certificates of appreciation to examiners in recognition of their dedication to evaluation process.

These percentages provide an overview of the academic performance in each course and can be used to assess the success rates in the final examinations during the specified period. The overall pass percentage for all programs has been 95.14%.
