Hyperion - The Cultural Society

Hyperion: The Cultural Society of P.G.D.A.V. (M) has always bustled with multiple activities throughout the session. This year was also remarkable as we resumed our traditional method of offline learning and faced many challenges which helped us emerge stronger than ever. Hyperion started its work from the ECA admission process. We got nine admissions under ECA, but that was not a deterrent for the team and new students. We added over two hundred and fifty new students to the societies through college auditions.

Session 2022-23 was one of its kind for the cultural committee as both the faculty and core team put in their best effort to make our college proud. Hyperion undertook the challenge to organise multiple events:

Teacher's Day

The session started with the celebration of Teacher's Day on September 5, 2022. This was the first time in the history of the cultural committee to experience an event dedicated to our esteemed teachers which was conducted with excitement and zeal. The event was a kick start for the team Hyperion which further motivated us to organise more such events.

Agomoni 2022

To celebrate the homecoming of Maa Durga and seek her blessings, we hosted 'Agomoni 2022'. We celebrated the occasion with Indian classical music, Indian classical dance, and a handful of joyous performances with a full fledged Dhaker Baddi (the sound of Dhaak) to give the audience a taste of the traditional Durga Puja.

2. PGDAV College is the only college to have LED flood lights placed at 30m height (100ft) which is the prescribed height approved by International Cricket Council (ICC).
3. The light is 3000 lux at the centre wicket equal to that of the Arun Jaitley Stadium (Feroz Shah Kotla Stadium).
4. PGDAV College has 3 international centres, turf wickets, 3 turf practice wickets and 2 Astro turf practice wickets.
5. The College Football Team has won many tournaments and the previous tournament was 'The Reliance Foundation Youth Inter College Football Championship'.
6. The College Cricket Team has won its 1st Swami Dayanand Saraswati T-20 cricket tournament.

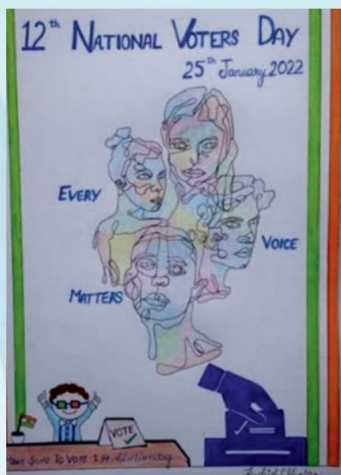

Chanakya

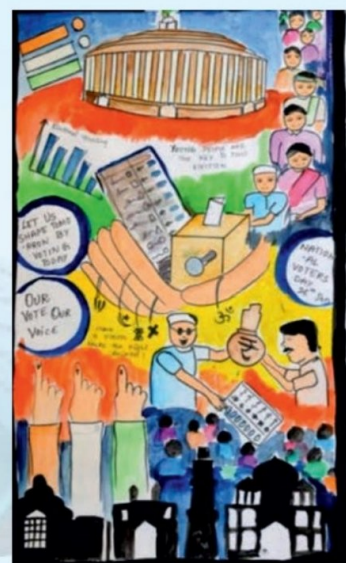

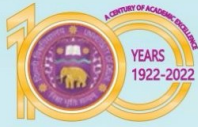

Deepali and Co-ordinators Drishti Verma, Preeti Deepa Dash, Eish Salooja, Mukul Lakhmani.

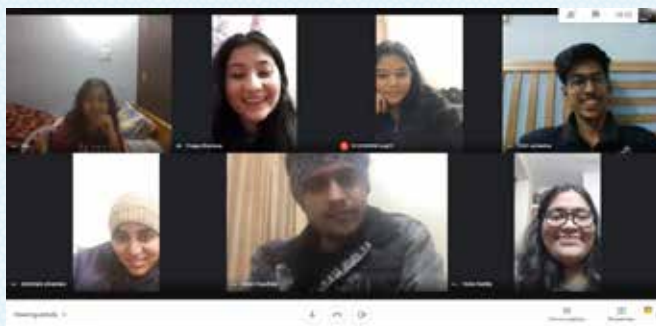

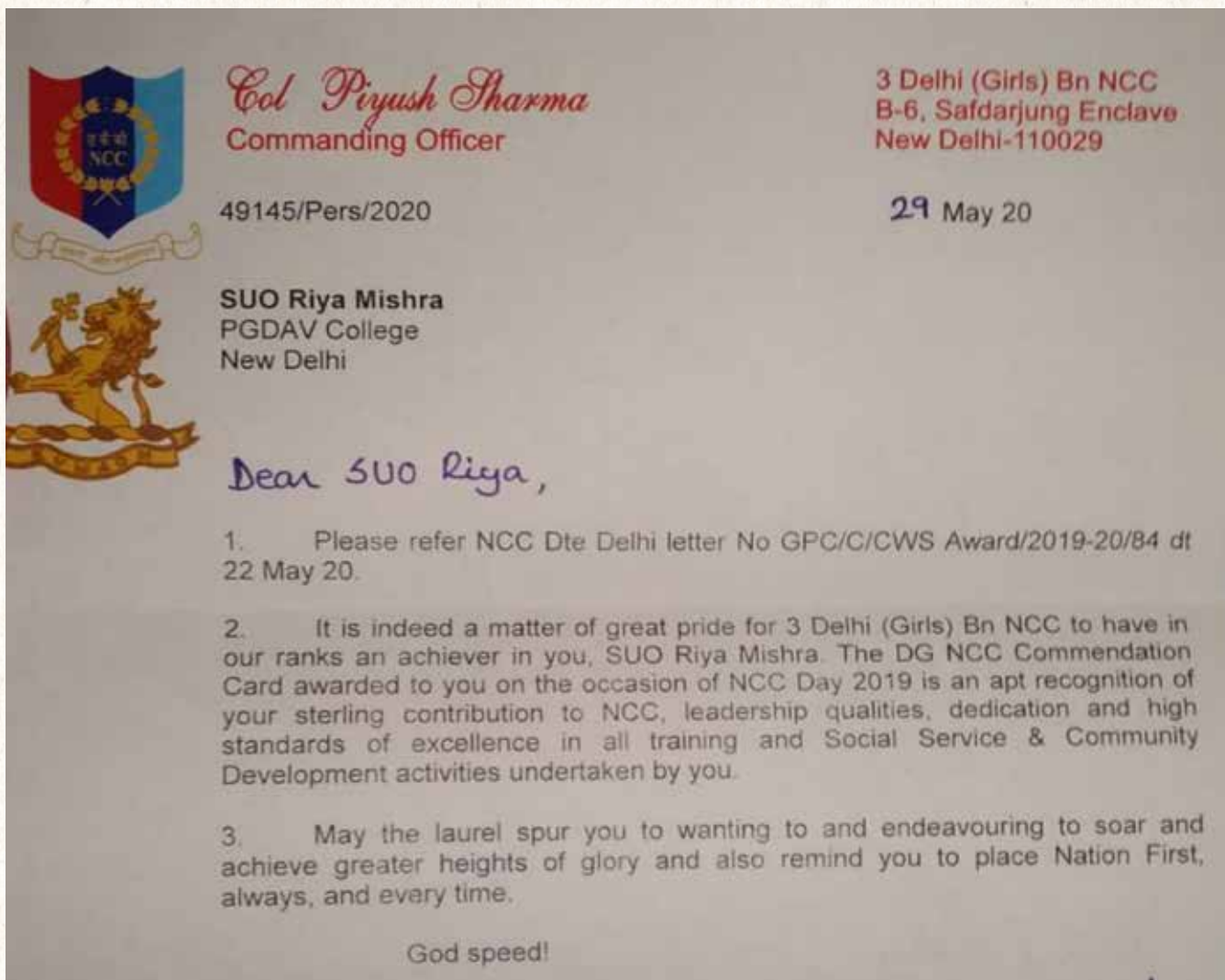
