- As planned two Faculty Development Programmes (FDP's) workshop was held during the academic year. Keeping in mind the emphasis and need for awareness on latest research tools available for teachers and scholars, an FDP on 'Research Methodology' was conducted successfully. The second FDP was organized by the Commerce Department in collaboration with Ramanujan College on the topic 'Contemporary Business Environment' that generated a lot of interest from faculty members across various departments. Both the FDP's invited well – known speakers and experts in their respective fields.
- In keeping with the idea of skill upgradation for non-teaching staff, a two- day workshop on 'LINUX 'was conducted. The participants found the workshop of great use and actually applied the outcomes for ease – of- work and efficiency.







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- 3. The English Department conducted the first international conference in the college inviting well- known speakers from abroad and from across the country. The two day conference on the subject '21<sup>st</sup> Century Indian Woman: Representations and Expressions' brought forth vibrant discussions on issues related to gender across disciplines. Four international speakers presented papers and participated in panel discussions, while eminent experts and academicians delivered keynote addresses, lead discussions and chaired sessions in which 42 papers were presented.
- Remedial Classes for students were conducted in the last week of the odd and even semesters at the end of every semester as they have proved to be useful in improving the overall results of the college and in making the students more confident of their knowledge.
- 5. The NSS established 'Astitva', as a project to provide free education to underprivileged children. The NSS students held classes for the children from nearby slums in the college and also provided them with study material. The project was greatly appreciated as very useful social service both by the college as well as the beneficiaries of the project.
- 6. All the members unanimously expressed satisfaction with the installation of six security cameras strategically placed throughout the college with the main control centre in the Principal's office. It was felt that the cameras provided better surveillance of the college campus.

The members reviewed the year's activities as follows:

1. All members expressed satisfaction with the successful shifting of all the important administrative work and teaching-learning process to the online mode. Most of the essential work after a short disruption went on uninterrupted.

2. There was unanimous appreciation for teaching faculties initiating their personal platforms with the students over Zoom, Google Meet etc. for taking lectures with each class in order to compensate for the disruption caused by the pandemic. In view of the extended online mode, the University provided G-Suite to all the teachers through College to enable audio/video lectures, interaction with students, uploading of assignments and other shared material, attendance records and grading etc. through this mode. It was also deeply appreciated that the teachers acted as councillors and interacted with the students both personally and academically to keep the student morale up during the stressful time of the increasing number of COVID cases affecting families. The students were given official id's which helped both the students and the college mutually to provide all information required during this period.

3. The members appreciated the efforts of the College and Department level Societies engaging and successfully conducting their activities through online mode.

4. The Department of Mathematics successfully organized a three- day national conference as planned on Advances in 'Mathematical Analysis and its Applications' in collaboration with Department of Science and Technology. Discussions and papers updated the teachers and students with the latest advancements in this field.





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5. The national conference planned by the Department of Commerce could not be held due to pandemic disruption. It was decided that the conference be postponed to the next academic session.

6. The Department of Commerce organized an FDP on 'Accounting Standards' for faculty members that refreshed the teaching- learning skills and updated the subject knowledge through interaction with highly accomplished and experienced experts.

7. It was felt that the NSS demonstrated sincere and effective work ethic. The team launched 'PratibhaShakti' and other initiatives to provide vital information, interaction, and services to underprivileged women. NSS was also appreciated for carrying forward project 'Astitva' to provide free education to underprivileged children by holding regular classes for the children from nearby slums in the college and providing them with study material including books, notebooks, pens, pencils etc.

8. Enactus displayed its social responsibility objectives too by successfully launching 'Nistaaran', through which the students undertook the challenge of spreading cleanliness by combining their efforts with waste pickers to inculcate and create awareness about the importance of cleanliness. The team also launched project 'Sugandh' by successfully training the underprivileged community, dwelling close to the College, to convert cow-dung into marketable organic aromatic incense sticks.

9. All the members expressed satisfaction with the timeliness of the appointment of a professional psychologist on campus to provide personal consultation, particularly, in view of the increased trauma due to the pandemic.

The meeting started with the recitation of the Gayatri Mantra.

Prof Krishna Sharma spoke in detail about the initiatives and steps that are being undertaken for the improvement of the College and the NAAC grade. Ms. Anu Kapur supplemented the initiatives by outlining the main areas that are going to be the focus for this academic year.

These areas were listed as follows:

1. To strengthen the alumni base of the College.

2. To make the College more PwD friendly. Tactile tiles are to be laid down for the purpose. The Equal Opportunity Cell is to be shifted to the ground floor for easier accessibility.

3. Skill Enhancement Courses and Certificate Courses to be offered regularly.

4. FDPs for staff members are also to be offered.

5. General Environment of the College is to be improved. Apart from increasing the green cover a fruit garden, butterfly conservatory is to be set up. Native trees like palaash are to be planted. The boundary wall is to be beautified with creepers. An E-waste cell and a compost cell already exist in the College. The College will also try to have a green audit.



Undertake such initiatives.

7. Encourage the research culture in the College. Have a Central Institutional Committee to discuss and encourage research projects. The College is also thinking of coming out with Journal.

8. The College website is to be improved and professional help has already been engaged for the purpose.

Dr. Ajay Suri laid emphasis on the importance of library and latest journals. The faculty members should be encouraged to use the library facilities on a daily basis and share their readings with their colleagues. He also suggested that the College should invest in going through the upcoming NEP and plan the future of the College in conjunction with it. It was also pointed out that due to COVID, the logistics of offering skill development courses is being hampered and we should find ways to tackle such issues

Dr. Satish Khosla offered to help the College to collaborate with a private company and offer training on block chain technology for our students. In fact he suggested that once set up the College could offer the same course to the students of other DAV institutions. This collaboration he said would come at zero cost to the College. He also expressed keen desire to be associated with the steps that College would take regarding making the campus PwD friendly. He offered to provide funding for the QR coding (??).

Dr. Mukesh Agarwal also emphasized the important role that alumni can play in the development of the College.
