#### **SAMVAAD Report**


On 28th November, 2020 Samvaad organised its 'Orientation Program' to officially welcome and induct the Freshers who joined the Political Science (Hons.) course in the 1st year. The Freshers were introduced to the Faculty and were informed and made aware of the course structure, Samvaad's legacy and major annual events, PGDAV College and various societies of the college. On 5<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 Samvaad organised an Open Book Examination (OBE) session to make students aware of the nitty-gritties of this new format of online examination.

French writer Anatole France said, "To accomplish great things, we must not only act, but also dream; not only plan, but also believe." Samvaad too with its 'Vision 2020+1' did not just plan or dream but, even in the shortest of time and in the limited virtual setting, started working tirelessly to implement, execute and put to action these numerous plans which were envisioned. With the beginning of the 'Even' semester from 4th January 2021, Samvaad begin working at full blast and organised numerous events in the semester. In the month of January an Intra-department Debate Competition on the topic 'Censorship of OTT platforms' was held, an Online Treasure Hunt, Movie Review Session and E-Sports Event was also conducted. The process of Learning is not limited to the spaces of classes and textbooks, but is ubiquitous and a continuous process, and to enrich this learning, on 13th January 2021 Samvaad organised an Intra-Department Quiz Competition. Samvaad organised an Intra-Department Poetry-cum-Tutorial Session — "कवी कविताएँ और संवाद" which was aimed at imparting the basics of poetry composition to the students.

**'Know Your Republic'** is an annual event organised by Samvaad to celebrate the *Republic Day of India* which helps us make students aware of the various tenets and facets of our Republic. This year, while several societies cancelled or minimized their events, Samvaad on the other hand decided to extend the celebrations to a 2-day event and organised a multitude of events on 22nd and 23rd January, 2021. A webinar was organised on the topic "Indian Constitution and its Philosophy" and the speaker for the event was *Professor Ujjwal Kumar Singh* from the *Department of Political Science, University of Delhi.* Other events organised in the two day 'Know your Republic 2021', which saw immense participations from several colleges and universities, were Inter College Quiz Competition, Inter College Treasure Hunt Competition, Inter College Debate Competition and Inter College Poster making Competition.

Samvaad issued the very first edition of the proposed monthly E-magazine of Samvaad, titled, **'THE DIALOGUE'** in which Students from all three years of the department contributed eloquently written articles on various issues and happenings of January 2021 ranging from *Farm Bills*, 'Love Jihad' Act to US President Biden, India at UNSC.

On 15th February, 2021 Samvaad organised a Webinar on the topic - "President Joe Biden and US-India Relations" for which *Dr. Rajan Kumar (School of International Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University)* was invited as



the "Guest Speaker". The session was highly informative and educational for all the students as it gave them an excellent opportunity to understand in detail the bilateral relations of India and USA and this crucial aspect of India's foreign policy and global politics through the deep insight and knowledge of Dr. Rajan Kumar.

Samvaad held its annual fest - 'SAMaigUTSAV 21' on 9th and 10th March, 2021 under the theme 'Justice: Through the Ages'. The fest began with keynote Webinar, on the topic 'On the Site and Scope of Justice', by our Guest Speaker Prof. Ashok Acharya who eloquently talked about Justice and various facets. Further the fest was packed with a plethora of events like '¿Quizocracy?' -

Inter-college Quiz Competition on the theme – 'Millennial India', 'तर्क-Vitark'21'- Inter-college Debate Competition on the topic 'Public Interest Litigation (PIL) is an instrument of Socio-Economic Justice', 'Alfaaz-e-Hunar', An Inter-College Online Open Mic Competition, Photography and short film making competition, 'Khel T.R.P Ka'- News Presentation Competition and 'Earth Parliament' to encourage young minds to discuss, deliberate and find solutions to the global ecological crisis. As a closing event an online **Talk Show** was organised with Speaker **IAS Miss Ira Singhal**, who talked about several key issues like the role of administration in ensuring Justice, Women empowerment, bureaucracy, etc. The versatile family of Samvaad portrayed their immense talent digitally with two short films that were screened during the events. Through these short films, Samvaad tried to shed light upon two social menaces prevalent in our societies. The film "KHAMOSHIYA" dealt about depression while the second short film "AFSOOS" highlighted the many vices of drugs and its abuse among the youth.

Samvaad has come out better and stronger from the tough times of the global pandemic and the entire team or rather family of Samvaad has shown utmost dedication and commitment to keep the students of the department engaged and in action constantly and even in the coming times Samvaad continues to strive for such excellence.


