

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The North East region of India comprises eight states – the seven sisters (Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, and Tripura) and Sikkim - each with its own distinct history and identity. North East is a melting pot of about two hundred tribes and a similar number of languages and dialects. Twothirds of the region is hilly terrain; the rest is flat valleys, including Brahmaputra, Barak, and Imphal valleys. Strategically located at the tri-junction of the south, southeast, and East Asia, the region shares its borders with Bhutan, China, Myanmar, and Bangladesh and has been one of the most sensitive regions in India. The present Faculty Development Programme (FDP) is an attempt in the above direction with the objective of bringing together renewed experts of diverse disciplines in the North East together for an interactive audience of teachers belonging to social sciences humanities from colleges and universities across the nation. Of late, there has been much emphasis on an interdisciplinary approach to pedagogy and research. The present FDP, therefore, lays down great stress on a multidisciplinary approach to understand the region holistically, tackle the challenges and bring into reality the prospects of the North. The themes of this FDP are decided insightfully so that participants are bound to get new pedagogical and research skill analyzing issues relevant broader to methodological framework. This FDP is designed, therefore, to make value addition to the pedagogical and knowledge processes o f the participants substantively.
