Communication is the act of sharing information, ideas and feelings. It can be verbal, written, visual (illustrations) and nonverbal (body language, postures and gestures). Effective communication is not just one of the most sought-after soft skills but also considered an important life skill. Strong communication skills bring success in professional as well as personal life.

People with good communication skills reflect confidence, have high self-esteem and enjoy a healthy interpersonal relationship with friends and family.

This certificate course is systematically designed to introduce students to the fundamentals of business and interpersonal communication. It intends to improve their verbal, nonverbal and written communication. The course will also familiarize students with the issues of ethics and plagiarism. Overall, it aims to equip students with communication skills essential for their academic, personal and professional lives.



This course will broadly address the following topics:

- Communication basics: sender, receiver, message, medium.
- Understanding self and audience
- Encoding and decoding
- Communication: five Ws and one H
- Business communication and its scope
- Corporate communication basics
- Verbal communication: language and its use, principles of verbal communication, lessons for facing personal interviews.
- Non-verbal communication: body language, speech movement
- Written communication: styles, principles, barriers, overcoming barriers
- Written communication: text, email, writing resume and personal statements

- Importance of visuals in communication, presentation and persuasion
- Listening skills: hearing vs listening, active listening
- Group communication and its dynamics, lessons for facing group discussion
- Intercultural and international communication
- Communication lessons for using social networking sites effectively
- Ethics and plagiarism in communication

After completing this course, students will have a greater understanding about the need and importance of effective communication in various interactions. They will obtain new insights about drafting their communications such as class presentation, personal statements for seeking admissions in higher education institutes, facing personal interviews, group discussions and managing their virtual profile through professional social networking sites. Moreover, intercultural and international communication will equip them in appreciating the communication dynamics and devising their acculturation strategy.

Duration

The certificate course will be completed in 30 hours. The students will attend two hours of online session (3-5 PM) for 15 days, starting from 12th April 2021 to 28th April 2021.

Mode of Teaching

The mode of teaching will be online through Google meet. The link for each session will be shared in advance with the students.

Eligibility

Any regular student of PGDAV College interested in learning effective communication skills is eligible to register for the course. The admission will be on a first-come, first-served basis.


