

Courses Offered & Distribution of Seats

Undergraduate Programmes

PGDAV College is a constituent College of the University of Delhi. The academic curriculum is adopted and used as approved by the University. The Undergraduate courses on offer fall under the purview of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, adopted by the University of Delhi.

The NEP 2020 envisages imparting academic knowledge, technical and professional-skills as well as life-skills as part of holistic education. In addition to the academically rigorous Discipline Centric Electives and Generic Electives (GE), the University of Delhi has also augmented the curricula with Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and Value-Added Courses (VAC) in various domains.

Skill Enhancement Courses provide students different kinds of skills, such as communication, coding, financial literacy, etc. which is combined with hands-on-learning so that the students get trained for the professional path they choose.

The Value Added Courses intend to impart a sound value system to the youth.
