




In the dynamic landscape of consumerism and digital innovation, Satark, the Consumer Club of PGDAV College, has been at the forefront of fostering awareness and action among its members. Through a series of meticulously organised events and initiatives, Satark has sought to empower individuals with the knowledge and skills necessary to navigate the complex realm of consumer rights, environmental responsibility, and technological advancements.

Commencing in **September 2023 on 25th**, Satark embarked on its journey by hosting a **Canva workshop**, where members were immersed in the realm of graphic design.. This workshop equipped our members with the relevant skills and knowledge necessary to use Canva and other graphic designing tools to create innovative posters and videos. Following this, in **October 2023 on 3rd**, Satark organised its first Knowledge Sharing Session (KSS) focused on the "**Consumer Protection Act 2019**", this session provided invaluable insights into the rights and duties of consumers, emphasising the importance of accountability and redressal mechanisms in safeguarding consumer interests, approximately **85+ students** attended the KSS. With a keen eye on environmental sustainability, Satark spearheaded a week-long e-waste drive in November 2023. In the digital age, rapid advancement in technology has led to the generation of a high amount of electronic waste, which has become a pressing global issue. To shed light on this cause, Satark successfully organised a week-long **e-waste drive** from **1st November to 7th November**. It aimed to raise awareness about the proper disposal of electronic waste and promote responsible recycling practices. Over seven days, **approximately 25 kilograms** of electronic waste, including tablets, laptops, and cables, were collected. The drive saw enthusiastic participation from both college faculty and students, highlighting the collective commitment towards environmental stewardship. In the same month on **29th November**, Satark turned its attention towards the burgeoning threat of cybercrime in the digital age. Through a seminar which saw a footfall of over 80+ attendees was led by **Ms. Agila G Senior Manager and Faculty at Indian Bank, STC Noida**, as the keynote speaker to share her valuable insights and knowledge with our students on the topic "**Cyber Crime and Redressal**". During the seminar, participants learned about different types of online scams like phishing, pop-up windows, trojan horse, and vishing. By teaching people how to recognize and prevent these online threats, the seminar aimed to help everyone become more aware and secure when using the internet. While addressing critical consumer issues, Satark also embraced creativity as a tool for advocacy. From towering burgers to overflowing fries and tantalising desserts, fast-food advertisements often paint a picture of culinary delight. However, beneath this glossy facade lies a stark reality. To unveil the truth behind fast food marketing, Satark organised the "**Memezaar- The Meme Making Competition**" in collaboration with **Consumer India**. Themed "Fast Food Illusions: Unmasking Marketing vs Reality," the competition ran from **November 5th to November 30th**, attracting over **75 entries**. The aim was to encourage participants to creatively expose the illusions of fast-food marketing while remaining aligned with the cause of consumer advocacy.

Transitioning into 2024, Satark continued its mission of enlightenment and engagement. A virtual KSS On **1st February** explored the "**Social Impact Of Artificial Intelligence (AI) On Consumers**", paving the way for informed discourse on the ethical and practical implications of technological advancement. Our vice president Divyanshi Singh and executive member Yashika were the speakers who aimed to educate students about the

different impacts of Ai on consumers' daily life. Number of **attendees were 65+** . The speakers delivered an immensely interactive and informative seminar for our students. Further enriching the dialogue on consumer rights, a seminar was held on **22nd February** featured **Dr. Sunil Prakash, President of the Consumer Forum**, who shared invaluable insights on the topic "Understanding Consumer Rights and Redressal Mechanisms". Dr. Prakash engaged the audience with real-life examples and practical guidance, offering a deeper understanding of consumer rights in the marketplace, with a particular emphasis on food safety and transparent packaging. It felt like a big family coming together to delve into the complexities of consumer rights, with over **250 participants** contributing to an enriching dialogue on consumer welfare. In addition to seminars and workshops, Satark actively engaged with students from diverse academic backgrounds through inter-college competitions. An Inter-college Article writing Competition was organised from **12th February to 02th March 2024** in association with **Consumers Forum**. The topic for this competition was "Fair and responsible AI for consumers" The competition proved to be a great success with an active participation of 35 students from various universities, cash prize worth 2000 rupees was awarded to winners. Led by President Aryan Maan and 4 committee members, The Consumer Grievance cell is always alert and ready to solve any type of scam or fraud that any student or faculty may encounter. On the 29th March 2024, Satark organised a webinar on "**LinkedIn Profile Optimization**", featuring esteemed **alumni Ananya Sinha**, Vice President of Satark during the 2021-22 session. Ananya, the founder of YSquare Marketing, shared her expertise with attendees. With over **25k+ followers and 1.9M+ views** on LinkedIn, she provided valuable insights and strategies for optimising LinkedIn profiles effectively. Entering **March and April**, SATARK organised its annual consumer fest, **Consumifiesta 2.0**. This dynamic event featured four engaging competitions aimed at promoting consumer awareness and creativity. 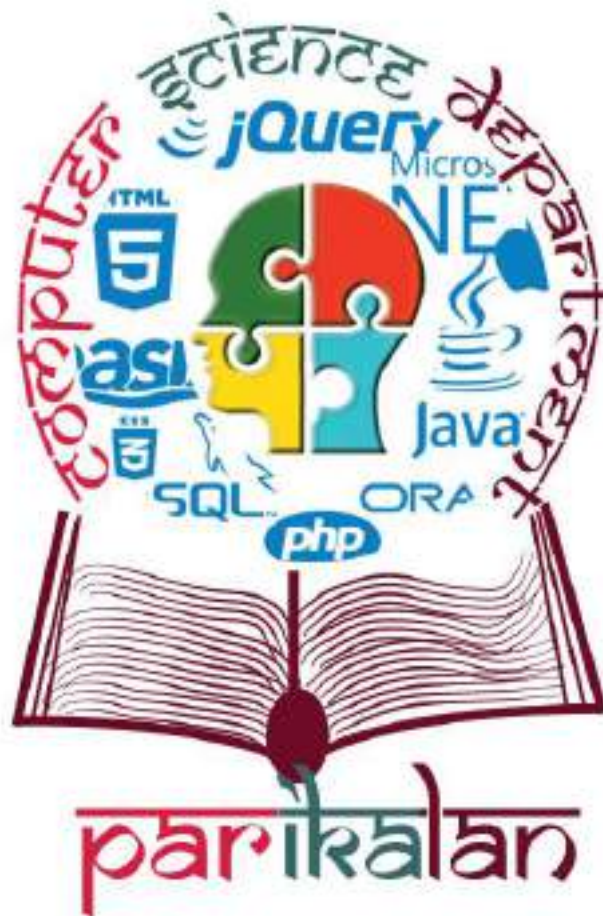

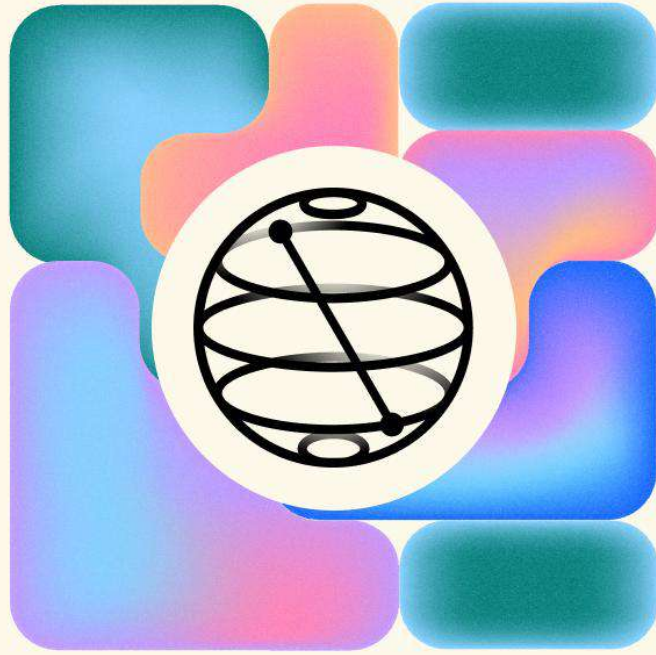

Discussion on the Book “Economics of Small Things”

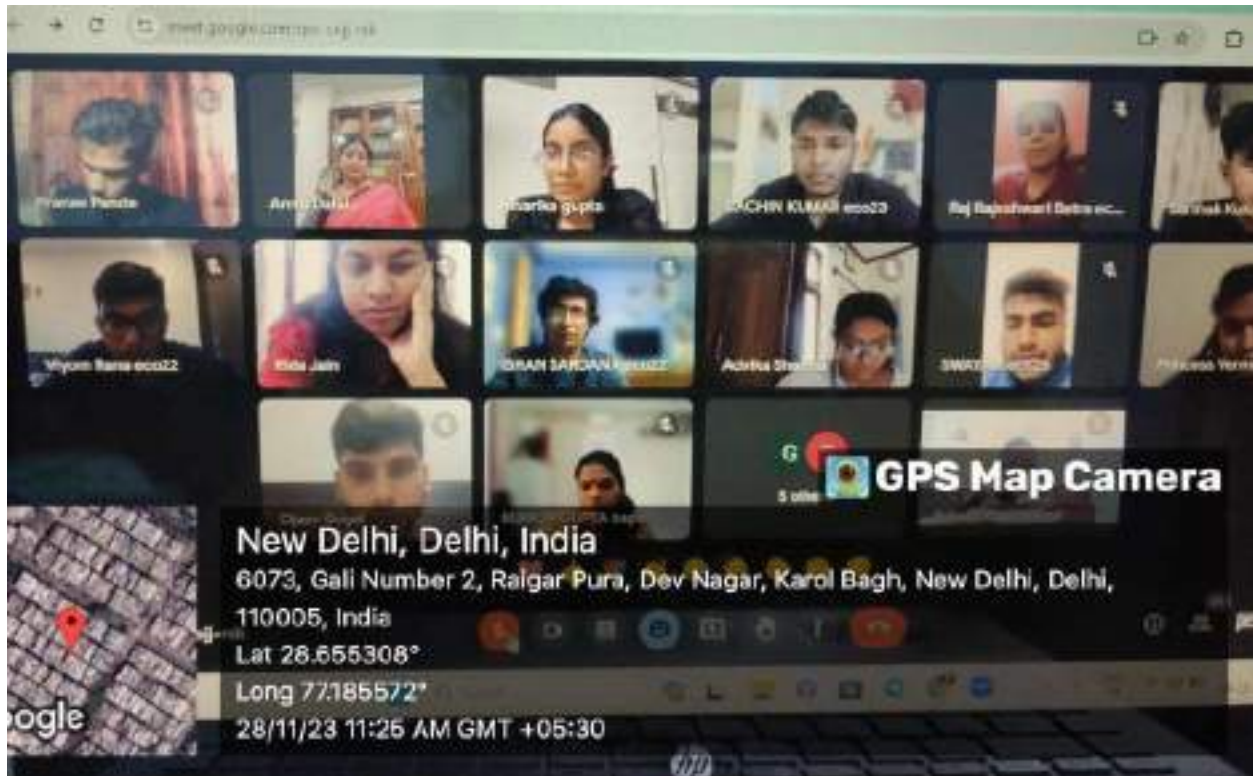

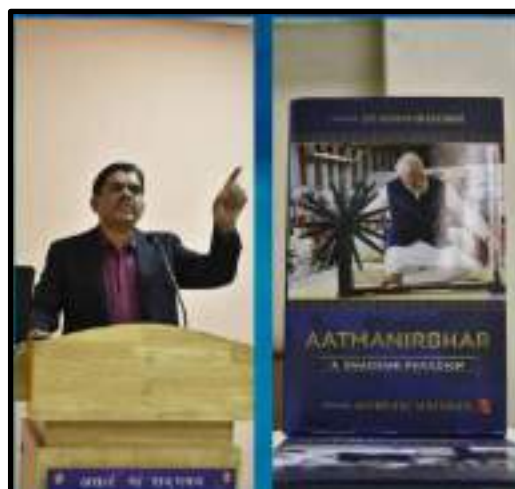

प्रो. के.पी. सिंह ने अपने उद्बोधन की शुरूआत प्राचार्या मैम को संबोधित करते हुए कहा कि जिसने घृणा और तृष्णा पर कंट्रोल किया वही कृष्णा है। उन्होंने अपनी बात को आगे बढ़ाते हुए कहा कि श्रीमद्भागवतगीता हमारे समय की उत्पन्न हर प्रोब्लम का साल्युशन देती है। गीता में चार पात्र हैं—धृतराष्ट्र, संजय, कृष्ण और भगवान् अर्जुन। पूरी कथा युद्ध के मैदान की है जो 24 घंटे की है। उन्होंने बच्चों को संबोधित करते हुए कहा कि आज टाइम किसी के पास नहीं है, हम अपने आप मोबाइल हो गए हैं। विश्व से जुड़े हैं। स्क्रीन टच तो है लेकिन “फिजिकली” किसी से टच में नहीं है। इसलिए इस तरह के पाठ्यक्रम की जरूरत सभी छात्र-छात्राओं को है। देश और विश्वविद्यालय में ‘अमृत काल’ चल रहा है। जहां चार हजार से अधिक एप्वाइंटमेंट, दस हजार से अधिक अलग-अलग लेवल के प्रमोशन हुए हैं। उसके बाद सही अर्थों में राम राज्य की परिकल्पना साकार होने जा रही है। सुपरचार्ज योर माइंड के बारे में उन्होंने कहा कि इस तरह के सर्टिफिकेट कोर्स कई कॉलेजों ने शुरू किया है। यह विद्यार्थियों के लिए बहुत उपयोगी सिद्ध होगा। इससे पहले शाइनिंगमून शशि फाउंडेशन के संस्थापक आचार्य श्री शशि प्रभुपाद जी ने आगामी पन्द्रह दिनों में कैसे पढ़ाएंगे। इस पर संक्षिप्त रूप से प्रकाश डाला। प्रभुपाद जी ने कहा कि मन, बुद्धि और आत्मा को समझने का प्रयास हम आगामी दिनों में करेंगे। मन उड़ती पतंग है। हर एक दिन में अलग अलग कामना है। जब कामनाओं की पूर्ति नहीं होती तो मन अशांत हो जाता है। मन को शांति कैसे प्राप्त होगी। आकाश में बहुत बारे तारे हैं चांद एक है। वही शीतलता प्रदान करता है।



श्री प्रभुपाद ने कई दृष्टांतों के माध्यम से अपनी बातों को समझाने का प्रयास किया। आहार, भय, निद्रा और मैथुन पाश्विकता है। सबके पास ऊर्जा है। उसका प्युरिफिकेशन करना है। दर्पण साफ नहीं होता तो उसमें तस्वीर साफ नहीं दिखती। दुनिया का मैल और दुख जम जाता है तब 'मन' सही नहीं देख पाता। उन्होंने यह भी कहा कि कुछ लोग प्रिय बात करते हैं लेकिन हम सत्य बातें करेंगे। कई बार मासूम और कोमल सा दिखने वाला आदमी बहुत खूंखार होता है। इसका कारण यह है कि उसकी बाहर की दुनिया ठीक है। परन्तु अंदर की दुनिया ठीक नहीं है। बाहर की दुनिया स्कूल, कॉलेज, और सामाजिक परिवेश से ठीक होता है। वहीं अंदर की दुनिया इस तरह के पाठ्यक्रम से ठीक होती है।

सुपरचार्ज जैसे पाठ्यक्रम सुख, समृद्धि, शान्ति और सफलता के लिए जरूरी है जो शारीरिक और मानसिक मतलब होलेस्टीक डेवलपमेंट से ही आ सकता है। यह इस कार्यक्रम / पाठ्यक्रम का उद्देश्य है। इस अवसर पर अपने अध्यक्षीय भाषण में महाविद्यालय की प्राचार्या प्रो. कृष्णा शर्मा ने कहा कि आज का दिन बहुत विशेष है। क्योंकि यह पाठ्यक्रम शुरू हो रहा है जो आपके पाठ्यक्रम से हटकर है। 'मन' की बात सभी शास्त्रों में हैं। आदरणीया प्राचार्या मैम ने आगे कहा कि गीता में विस्तार से 'मन' पर चर्चा हुई है। हम सब जानते हैं कि मन के हारे हार है मन के जीते जीत। मन चंचल है। उसको नियंत्रित करने वाला ही सफलता पा सकता है। मेंटल हेल्थ जिसका ठीक है वही शांति को प्राप्त करेंगे।

अपने उद्बोधन अगले भाग में उन्होंने कहा कि 'पश्चिम' वाले हमारी तरफ आ रहे थे और विडम्बना देखिए कि हम सभी अन्धानुकरण करने लगे थे। अपने अध्यक्षीय उद्बोधन के अंत में 22 जनवरी को अयोध्या में नवनिर्मित भव्य, दिव्य राममंदिर में भगवान् की प्राणप्रतिष्ठा का जिक्र करते हुए उन्होंने कहा कि 22 जनवरी को नया इतिहास लिखा गया। 26 जनवरी की तरह ही 22 जनवरी भी हमारे मानस में अंकित हो गया। यह कितनी दुखद बात है कि हमारे दो इतिहास पुरुष राम, कृष्ण हैं। उसमें से भगवान राम तम्बू में थे। इससे पहले इस उद्घाटन समारोह की शुरुआत दीपप्रज्वलित करके एवं मंगलाचरण से किया गया। उसके बाद स्वागत

मन चाहे किसी का भी हो उसमें 80 प्रतिशत सत्त्व गुण है—प्रो. ओम नाथ बिमली

प्रोफेसर बिमली सर ने सबसे पहले अपने भाषण की शुरूआत में कृतज्ञता व्यक्त करते हुए कहा कि इस पीजीडीएवी महाविद्यालय का, इस महाविद्यालय की प्राचार्या का, संस्कृत

विभाग के आचार्यों को मैं कृतज्ञता व्यक्त करता हूँ जिन्होंने मुझे इस महनीय एवं महत्वपूर्ण पाठ्यक्रम के समापन सत्र में मुझे आमंत्रित किया। मैं विद्यार्थियों की दृष्टि से ही इस विषय पर अपनी बात रखूंगा। मुझे यह विषय बहुत ही समसामयिक एवं प्रासंगिक लगा। “सुपरचार्ज योर माइंड” इस विषय के कई अलग-अलग परिप्रेक्ष्य हो सकते हैं, लेकिन मैं “भारतीय दर्शन” के परिप्रेक्ष्य में ही अपनी बात कहूंगा।

फिर प्रो. दिलीप सर को संबोधित करते हुए उन्होंने कहा कि मैं चला समय पर लेकिन समय पर नहीं पहुंच सका। वसीम बरेलवी का शेर भी सुनाया।

‘मन एव मनुष्याणां कारणं बन्धमोक्षयोः।’ इसका मतलब है कि मन ही मनुष्य के बंधन और शाश्वत शांति यानि मोक्ष का भी कारण है। कैसा मन बंधन का कारण है और कैसा मन मोक्ष का कारण है? मन जब सुपरचार्ज हो जाता है तब वह अपने लक्ष्य तक पहुंचता है। मन शुद्धिकरण तक पहुंचता है तब ही वह आपको अपने गन्तव्य तक पहुंचा सकता है। जब भारतीय अध्यात्म की बात होगी तब मन का सुपरचार्ज होने का मतलब है मन का पूरा सात्त्विकरण होना। एक है आत्मा और आत्मा के अतिरिक्त जो कुछ भी है वह शरीर है। एक प्रकृति है दूसरा पुरुष है। प्रकृति तीन गुणों से बना हुआ है। प्रकृति त्रिगुणात्मक है और पुरुष निर्गुण है।

यह संसार प्रकृति के ही भिन्न-भिन्न रूप है। जैसे मिट्टी से बना घड़ा, गणेश जी की मूर्ति, दीया। इसी तरह प्रकृति के ही भिन्न-भिन्न रूप हैं। एक रूप है मन। इस तरह संसार त्रिगुणात्मक है, क्योंकि प्रकृति से बना है। प्रकृति से ही मन निर्मित है, इसलिए मन भी त्रिगुणात्मक है। वस्तुएं प्रकृति से बनी हैं लेकिन कुछ वस्तुएं ऐसी हैं जिसमें 95% तमस हैं शेष रजस् और सत्त्व है। इस तरह यह पूरी तरह से तामसिक पदार्थ है, लेकिन मन जो है वह प्रकृति का सात्त्विक पदार्थ है। मन में चाहे किसी का भी हो उसमें 80% सत्त्व है लेकिन पत्थर में 95 प्रतिशत तमस है। इसलिए मन चाहे महर्षि दयानंद का हो या विवेकानंद का या फिर हिटलर या मुसोलिनी का। अब एक उदाहरण से समझिए कि हिटलर और गांधी के मन में क्या अंतर है। उसमें यही अंतर है कि 20 प्रतिशत जो मन है उसमें से 10 प्रतिशत को गांधी ने सात्त्विक कर लिया। इस तरह गांधी के पास 90% सात्त्विक मन है वहीं 5 प्रतिशत



तामसिक और 5 प्रतिशत राजसिक मन है। जबकि हिटलर के पास 80 प्रतिशत सात्त्विक मन तो था लेकिन 20 में से 10 प्रतिशत को तामसिक बना लिया, जिससे हिटलर के पास 80 प्रतिशत सात्त्विक मन और 15 प्रतिशत तामसिक एवं शेष 5 प्रतिशत राजसिक मन बना लिया। इस तरह गांधी ने अपने मन को सुपरचार्ज कर लिया वहीं हिटलर ने अपने मन को और डिस्चार्ज कर लिया। सुपरचार्ज माइंड आत्म (सेल्फ) के साथ कनेक्ट करता है। आत्मा क्या है। आत्मा प्योर एवेर्नेश है। सच्चिदानन्द है प्योर (Pure) सत्ता है।

मनुष्यता के सामने तीन प्रकार के दुःख आते हैं। तीन प्रकार के दुःख है—आदिदैविक, आदिभौतिक एवं आध्यात्मिक। दुःख से कौन सबसे ज्यादा पीड़ित होता है जिसका माइंड सेल्फ से डिस्कनेक्टेड होता है। इसलिए मन का आत्मा से कनेक्शन जरूरी है। अब माइंड को ऐसे बनायेंगे तब ही मन एव मनुष्याणां.... हो सकता है।

मन को भारतीय संदर्भों में समझने की जरूरत है। आयुर्वेद, बौद्ध दर्शन, और योग दर्शन, इन तीनों में 'चतुर्व्यूह' का प्रयोग किया जाता है। आयुर्वेद में जो चतुर्व्यूह है उसमें पहला व्यूह है—रोग।

दूसरा व्यूह है रोग का कारण है। अगर कारण नहीं होता तो हर जगह रोग ही रोग होता। जहाँ कारण होता है वहाँ कार्य होता है। इसलिए रोग है और उसका कोई न कोई हेतु होता है।

तीसरा व्यूह है रोग निरोध। रोग हो लेकिन रोग का कोई न कोई कारण है लेकिन निरोध का कोई उपाय न हो तो रोग पर नियंत्रण नहीं हो सकता।

चौथा व्यूह है रोग निरोध के उपाय। यह आयुर्वेद का चतुर्व्यूह है। बौद्ध दर्शन का चतुर्व्यूह क्या है? चार आर्य सत्य है। दुःख है, दुःख हेतु है। दुःख निरोध है दुःख निरोध के उपाय हैं। उसी तरह योग दर्शन में चार व्यूह माने जाते हैं उसमें पहला है हेय, हेय मतलब त्याज्य, दूसरा है हेय का हेतु, हेय का हान, हेय के हान का उपाय।

शाइनिंगमून शशि फाउंडेशन के शशि प्रभु और मोनिका शर्मा ने पी.जी.डी.ए.वी. कॉलेज में हुए 15 दिनों के अनुभव को बताया।

अंत में धन्यवाद ज्ञापन प्रो. दिलीप कुमार झा सर ने किया। उन्होंने कहा कि हास्य विनोद के क्रम में हमने आज के मुख्य अतिथि और वक्ता प्रो. बिमली सर से कहा कि आजकल

कार्यक्रम का संचालन डॉ. कुलदीप कुमार ने किया। संचालन के क्रम में डॉ. कुलदीप ने कहा कि जिस तरह गुरुवर प्रो. ओम नाथ बिमली कहते हैं कि हंसराज कॉलेज उनका कॉलेज है, तो मैं यहां यह स्पष्ट कर देना चाहता हूँ कि अब पीजीडीएवी कॉलेज भी आपका ही कॉलेज है। आदरणीय दिलीप झा सर आपके क्लॉसमेट मित्र हैं, और आदरणीय गिरिधर सर से लेकर अंतिम पीढ़ी का मैं स्वयं आपका शिष्य हूँ। इसलिए अब पीजीडीएवी भी आचार्य परम्परा से आपका ही कॉलेज है।

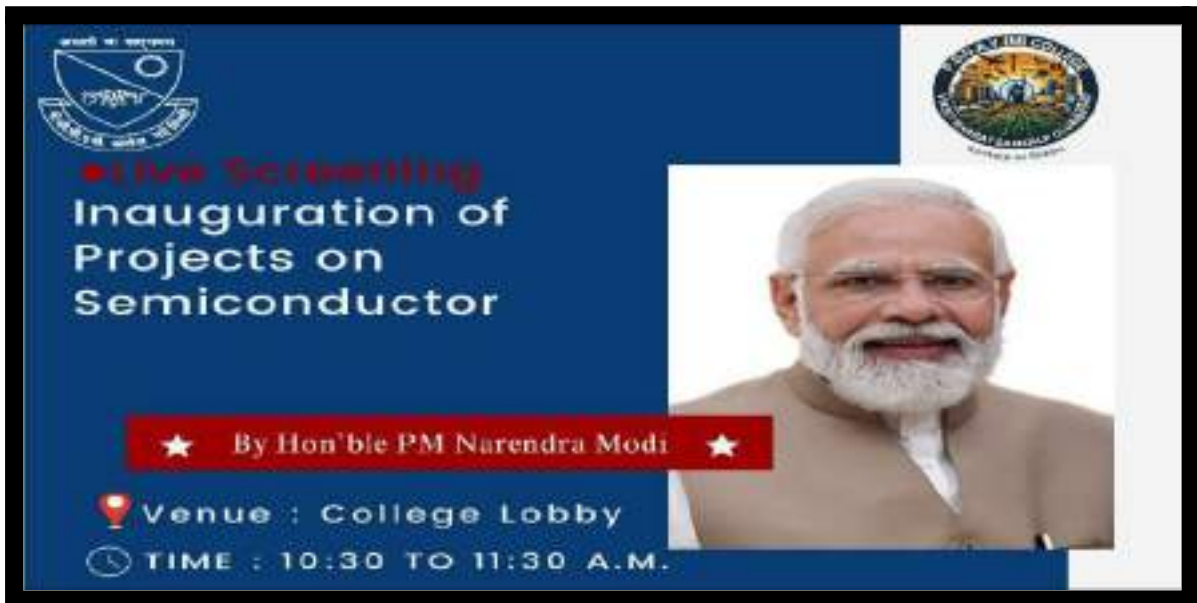

8. Description of the Event:

On 22nd April 2024, a seminar was conducted on clinical psychology in collaboration with AIIMS Delhi by Commercium: The Commerce Society at PGDAV College. The objective of the seminar was to introduce the students to the basics of human psychology and the issues that young adults face, specifically during this stage of life. The session began with a brief introduction of our first speaker, Dr Aman Dua. Dr Dua completed her MBBS in 2016, and has been awarded the prestigious Dr Indrayan award for biostatistics. She is currently pursuing her P.HD.

She started the seminar with a mindfulness exercise. Everyone present at the seminar hall was asked to close their eyes, relax their body, and breathe in and out for a few minutes. This may have been the first time meditating for many present in the hall but it set down the premise of an impactful session ahead. Dr Aman has been conducting multiple seminars of such kind. She shared her experience of visiting several colleges, before and after the 2020 COVID era and talking to students

about their psychological needs. The audience was then asked to fill a google form, called the 'The Stepping Minds' questionnaire. This survey focused on understanding a candidate's current mental well-being and whether they needed to seek help.

After Dr Dua's insightful session, we were introduced to Dr Nitin Lal, PGDAV's very own psychologist. Dr Nitin explained the symptoms of mental disorders in an easy-to-understand and concise manner. He also showed ways in which these can be observed in our routine activities.

Dr Lal presented a video that showed and identified the root causes of many mental disorders and how these disorders have been passed down to generations, due to not being addressed. He assured the students that they are free to consult him regarding their personal conflicts and that he will ensure a safe space for them to open up.

This was one of the last seminars that Commercium organised for the session 2023-24. The seminar addressed some serious topics and ensured help and guidance for each student. We could not have asked for a better end to the session.

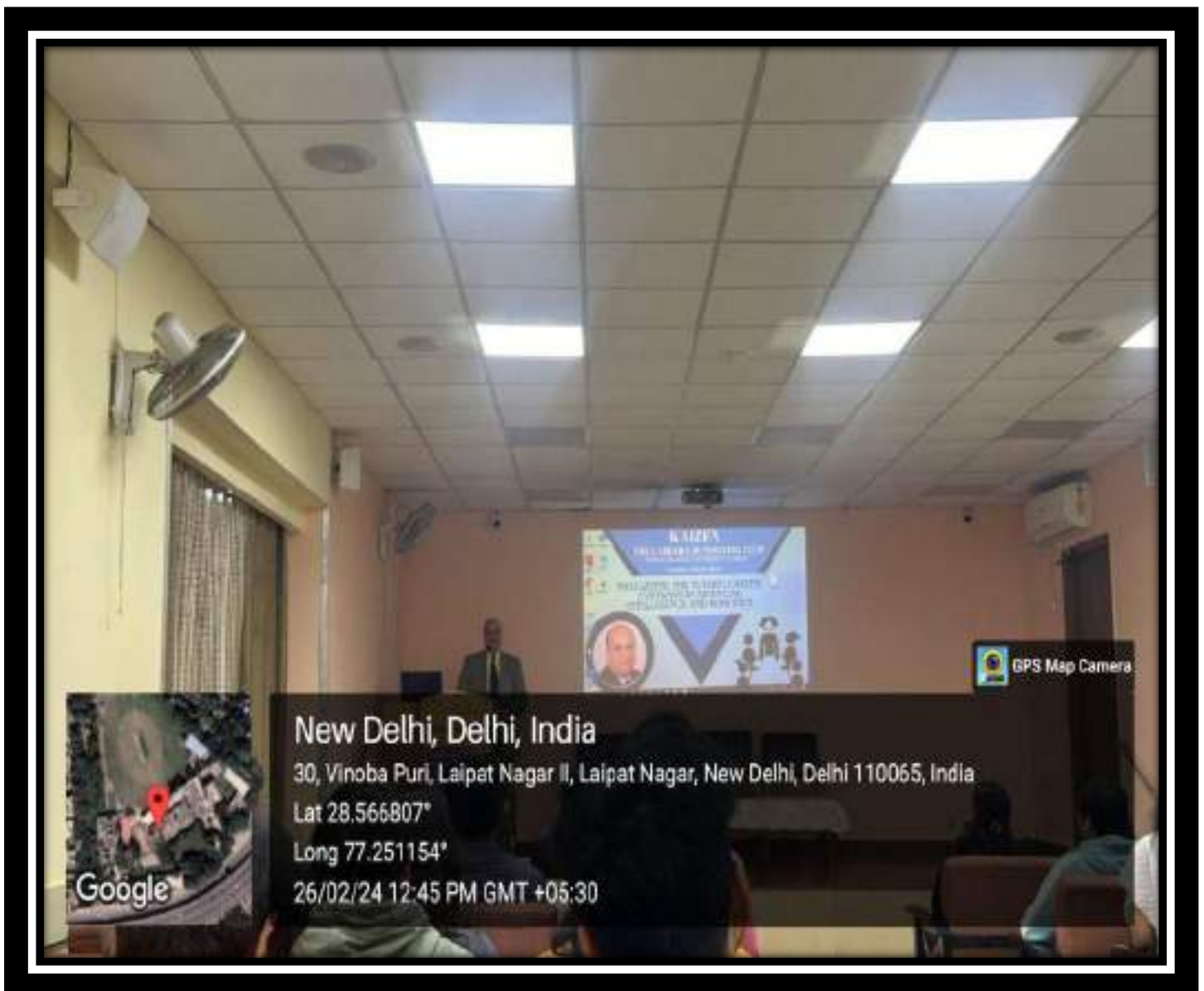
